

Select the type of record and its year

NB when scrolling through the pages of an individual register the system freezes if you attempt to view more than 5 pages every ten seconds. Use the page counter to jump large number of pages at a time. So to go from page 5 of the 1744baptismal record to look at the 1744 burial records delete the 5 in the page counter box and insert 83 and press enter
